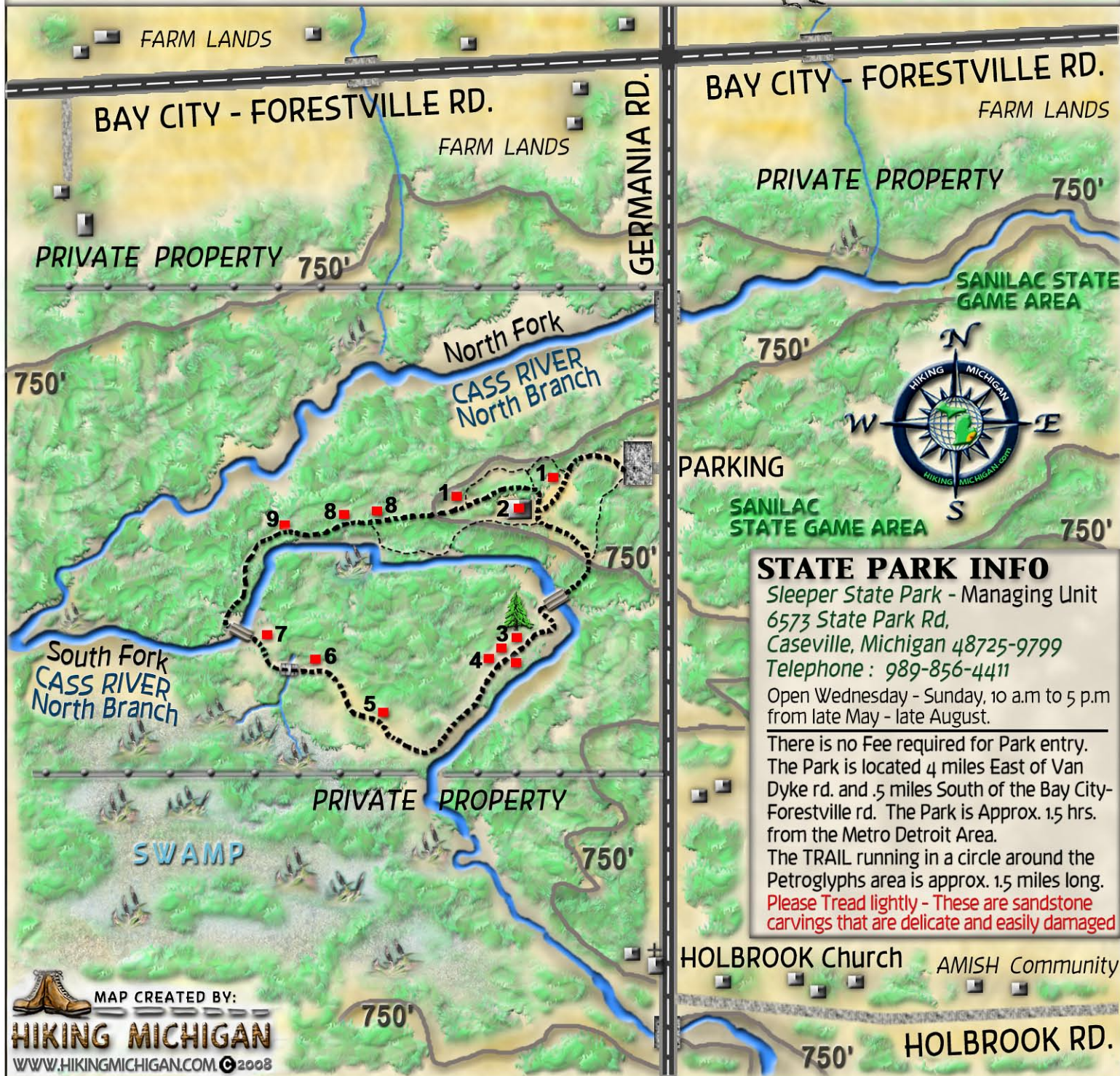

 from late May - late August.

There is no Fee required for Park entry.  
 The Park is located 4 miles East of Van Dyke rd. and .5 miles South of the Bay City-Forestville rd. The Park is Approx. 1.5 hrs. from the Metro Detroit Area.  
 The TRAIL running in a circle around the Petroglyphs area is approx. 1.5 miles long.  
**Please Tread lightly - These are sandstone carvings that are delicate and easily damaged**
